





THE MIDDLE YEARS DEVELOPMENT (MDI)

The MDI is coming to your school in January/mid-March!

Your district has partnered with the Human Early Learning Partnership (HELP) at the University of British Columbia to measure and promote children's social and emotional health, well-being and assets through the Middle Year Development Instrument (MDI).

Please keep in mind....

- 1. The MDI is voluntary: children, parents, teachers and schools are free to withdraw from participating.
- 2. The MDI data will be provided to your school in a School Report, followed by a School District Report.
- 3. This is a population-level tool—not an individual assessment.
- 4. Children's voices matter. The MDI lets children know that we value their thoughts and feelings, and provides an opportunity for self-reflection.

The MDI at a glance

- a self-report questionnaire gathering children's voices in Grade 4 to 8
- measures aspects of children's social and emotional development and well-being that align with the BC Ministry of Education's New Curriculum on Personal and Social Competencies
- developed collaboratively with researchers, educators, community and children
- offers valid and reliable data on children's development and well-being to support action aimed at creating conditions in which children can flourish

☐ Inform Parents/Guardians! **Distribute Parent/Guardian**Informed Passive Consent Letters at least <u>2 weeks</u>
before survey administration (excluding winter break).

i.e., to start on January 13, 2026, the opening date of the MDI, letter **must be distributed by mid-December.** Please adjust the administration time of the MDI according to when the parent/guardian letters went home.

	☐ Review your Class Lists and add/delete/withdraw students as necessary before the Survey Administration.
	☐ Print off student logins.
	☐ Administer the MDI. Students complete the <u>survey</u> <u>online</u> . The survey takes 45-60 minutes to complete. (See <u>Instructional Survey</u> for more information - coming soon.)
	☐ Follow-up with student requests for help.
	☐ Complete the <u>Survey Administrator Feedback Form</u> .
